SUBSIDISED PASSES FOR STUDENTS FOR URBAN AND EXTRA URBAN PUBLIC TRANSPORT IN BOLOGNA AND IMOLA FAQ

1) Who is eligible for the subsidy?

All students of the Alma Mater Studiorum – University of Bologna who are regularly enrolled in first cycle and second cycle degree programmes.

2) What kinds of public transport passes are subsidised?

- Annual urban public transport pass for the Bologna area
- Annual urban public transport pass for the Imola area
- Annual extra-urban public transport pass for the Bologna area

3) How much do the annual subsidised public transport passes cost?

All public transport pass types are eligible for a €40 discount off the TPER price (i.e. the annual urban public transport pass for Bologna will have a subsidised price of €180). Please refer to Annex 1 for the subsidised prices of all eligible public transport passes.

4) When it is possible to apply for a subsidised public transport pass?

Starting 1 November 2017.

5) How can I buy the subsidised public transport pass?

Through [Studenti Online](#) (SOL), paying by credit card.

6) How long is the pass valid for?

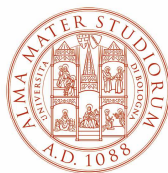
The pass is valid for one year. You can choose the start date when you buy the pass.

7) How is the pass collected?

By showing your identity card or passport, your university badge and the purchase receipt at the TPER Point located in Via Marconi 4, Bologna, [during office hours](#). You can print the purchase receipt after the online payment.

8) Are exchange students (Erasmus+ or those in other mobility programmes) eligible for any subsidies?

Yes. Exchange students (Erasmus+ or those in other mobility programmes) are eligible for specific subsidies according to the length of their mobility period at the Alma Mater Studiorum – University of Bologna, which are available only for the urban pass for the Bologna area. Log in to [Studenti Online](#) (SOL) with your university username and password to find out the pass price, its duration and how to buy and collect it.
