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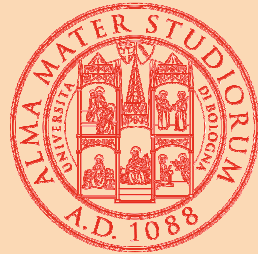

The **CLA** (University of Bologna Language Centre) offers free 50-hour Italian language courses to all exchange and international students.

## Who is the course for?

- **Exchange students** - can attend one free course during the academic year
- **International students** enrolled in a Degree Plan at the University of Bologna - can attend one free course in the first semester of their first year (in September)

*Italian language courses are **pass/fail** courses and are worth **5 ECTS credits***

- **A1 (absolute beginner)** - online assisted self-study course with 6 lessons in class. The courses of Italian A1 can be arranged in any of the 4 sites of CLA.
- **A2 (elementary)** - 50 hours: 30 hours in the classroom and 20 hours online self-study activities.
- **B1 (Intermediate)** - 50 hours: 30 hours in the classroom and 20 hours online self-study activities.
