Purposes and methods of processing

Images will be processed, including via digital means, by subjects specifically appointed for institutional purposes, in the context of research, cultural and educational activities, for University publication and communication activities, as well as for purposes pursuant to art. 4 of D.R. 271/2009 (University Consolidation Act on Privacy and on the Use of Information Systems).

Images may be published and shared on institutional websites as well as via social networking channels (including but not limited to, Facebook, Twitter and YouTube) pursuant to Law n. 150/2000, "Regulation of information and communication activities of public administrations".

The use of an image does not entitle the user to compensation of any kind.

The Alma Mater Studiorum - University of Bologna has the right to access or disclose user images without consent, pursuant to art. 97 of Italian law n. 633/1941. The use of images that may cause damage to the honour, reputation or dignity of the person portrayed, depicted or recorded is, under all circumstances, excluded pursuant to the aforementioned article and art. 10 of the Italian Civil Code.

For the legal basis of the processing please refer to art. 6, paragraph 1(e), of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (GDPR).

Data retention period

Personal data will be stored by Alma Mater Studiorum - University of Bologna pursuant to the principles set forth in art. 5 of EU regulation 679/2016 for a period of time not to exceed the fulfilment of the purposes they were collected for, with specific regard to the principle of limitation of conservation pursuant to art. 5, paragraph 1(e) of EU regulation 679/2016.

Nature of the Data

Rights of the data subject

In particular, data subjects have the right to ask the data controller for access to their personal data and its rectification and/or cancellation; to restrict processing that concerns them; to object to the processing of their data; and a right to data portability.

They also have the right to submit a complaint to the supervisory authority.
