This shall be defined together with the supervisor and approved by the Academic Board. Motivational letter. This must include the reasons prompting the applicant to attend the PhD Programme and those

- relevant experiences and research interests, that make the applicant suitable for the specific PhD Programme (3.000 characters maximum, including spaces).
- Scientific publications "in extenso" (monographs, articles published on scientific journals) (up to 10).
- Minor scientific publications "in extenso" (national or international conference papers, volume's chapters, etc.).
- Abstracts and posters in extenso presented during national and international conferences, etc. (up to 8).
- Professional Master courses (1st or 2nd level) relevant to the PhD Programme.
- Postgraduate vocational training programmes/specialisation programmes relevant to the PhD Programme.
- Summary of the thesis defended within the framework of Specialization Schools. The summary cannot exceed 5.000 characters.
- Teaching activity carried out at university level.
- Scientific research of any type (basic, oriented, targeted, translational, applied, etc.) and carried out in any capacity, including research grants and taking part in research projects.
- Documents attesting the knowledge of foreign languages.
- Study periods completed by students outside their countries of origin (e.g. Erasmus programme or other similar mobility programmes).
- Other documents certifying the applicant's training and abilities (grants, awards, etc.)

## Evaluation criteria

Points will be allocated to applications out of a total of 100 on the basis of the following weighting:

- 1. Qualifications and research project
  - Minimum for admission to the oral exam: 30 points
  - Maximum: 50 points

Only qualifications relating to the last 5 calendar years prior to the calendar year of publication of the Call for applications shall be taken into consideration, with the exception of the University Degree (Diploma di laurea). Please, note that qualifications must be consistent with the PhD Programme.

- Points relating to qualifications shall be allocated on the basis of the following criteria:
- Graduation final marks or, for undergraduates, Weighted Average Mark (WAM): up to 8 points;
- Quality of the research of the master's degree dissertation (2<sup>nd</sup> cycle specialist degree or master programme) as far as documented by the abstract of the degree dissertation: up to 6 points;
- Publications: up to 6 points.

# Other criteria:

- Letters of presentation: up to 1 point (half point for each reference letter);
- Participation to research activities: up to 3 points;
- other qualifications: up to 3 points.

Points relating to the research project shall be allocated on the basis of the following criteria:

- Scientific value and ground-breaking nature of the proposal: max 18 points;
- Description and structure of the proposal: up to 2 points;
- Proposal feasibility: up to 3 points;

## 2. Oral examination

- Minimum for inclusion in the final ranking list: 30 points

- Maximum: 50 points

Oral examination is intended to assess the suitability of the applicant to pursue scientific research as well as the general knowledge of issues connected to the PhD Programme.

During the oral examination, knowledge of English language shall be assessed.

The oral examination is carried out in Italian or in English, according to the applicant's choice.

Points relating to the oral examination shall be allocated on the basis of the following criteria:

- Knowledge of the English language: max 10 points;
- Research project presentation: max 20 points;
- General knowledge of issues connected to the PhD Programme: max 20 points.
