| Project description           | Plants, as the basis of all ecosystems on Earth, represent more than 80% of the planet<br>biomass. The human inability to grasp their presence and importance (plant blindness)<br>has led to the current state of biological vulnerability of the Earth. Children's Literature<br>highlights the ontological relationship of the human being with trees and other living<br>entities and, through metaphors and poetic images, helps the reader become aware of<br>this inescapable interdependence. The research wants to explore the - often radical -<br>perspective of this literature in order to identify an educational and didactic path<br>capable of real change in approaching the issues of sustainability. Aim of the project is<br>to promote expertise in conceiving, planning and realizing publishing products which<br>can be seen as an alternative or integration to traditional textbooks. These products,<br>drawing from the poetic perspective of children's literature, will have to support<br>teachers in sharing knowledge of the natural world with an interdisciplinary approach:<br>one that can bring together cognitive, aesthetic and emotional solicitation, and<br>encourage active, profound, ongoing participation on the part of the child reader.<br>Part of the research to be carried out in the company: 1) Needs analysis of the<br>organization, comprehension of how the environmental sustainability's value are<br>perceived and are implemented in the operating practices; 2) understanding of any<br>obstacles detected in the process of job placement of the vulnerable Person; 3)<br>interventions aimed at strengthening a green-type organizational culture and the work<br>placement of the vulnerable Person in green activities; 4) strengthening of the network<br>work and of the synergy with vocational training centers; 5) co-planning the vulnerable<br>Person's work placement in green activities; 6) evaluation of the perceived well-being<br>of the worker operating green activities and tasks. |

| Project description   | The future scenarios of today's ecological crisis have become common knowledge<br>among the public opinion. On the basis of the growing attention on this topic, the<br>theme gained a central role in political agendas and, as a reflection, in educational<br>contexts, including publishing industry and private agencies dedicated to the training of<br>experts and teachers. Regarding the situation just outlined, recent Italian laws and<br>decrees (92/2019 and 35/2020) introduced Civic education and Sustainability education<br>as a new subject in schools: so, it appears urgent to manage, generally speaking, the<br>absent or the insufficient degree of competences on the topic among the teachers. In<br>particular, the publishing sector specialized in education and in the production of tools,<br>teaching aids and courses (teaching materials, textbooks, MOOCs, on line courses)<br>needs the contribution of pedagogical research to guarantee teaching materials of high<br>quality, to support the teachers. The project aims at training a profile of researcher<br>capable of projecting, implementing and testing tools, teaching aids and courses of the<br>publishing industry, regarding both the contents and the didactic practices, in the field<br>of Sustainability education. |
