During the oral examination, applicants may express their interest in one or more positions linked to specific research topics.

Required and Supporting Documents to be attached to the application

Documents **in Italian or English only** shall be considered as valid and shall be assessed by the Admission Board. For identity documents and degrees issued in a language different from Italian or English, an official translation is required. The translation shall be drawn up by an authorized body or by the awarding University.

Qualifications obtained during the last 5 calendar years only shall be taken into consideration, except for the University Degree. The Admission Board will assess the relevance of the supporting documents to the PhD Programme.

Personal Statement	The statement shall include the reasons prompting the applicant to attend the PhD Programme and those relevant experiences and research interests that make the applicant suitable for the specific PhD Programme (3000 characters maximum, including spaces).		
Reference Letter/s	No more than 3 reference letters signed by Italian and/or international academics and professionals in the research field, which do not form part of the Admission Board, attesting the suitability of the applicant and his/her interest for the scientific research. Letters shall be uploaded following the procedure on Studenti Online , detailed in the Call for Applications (Art. 3.2).

Evaluation criteria *

Scores will be expressed in points out of 100, as follows.

1. Qualifications evaluation - Minimum score for admission to the oral examination: 30 points, Maximum score: 50 points

Second cycle degree final mark. Graduands (or graduates coming from Universities awarding degrees without a final mark) shall be evaluated on the basis of the Weighted Average Mark (WAM)	13 points max
Curriculum Vitae. This includes the academic prestige of the universities where the degrees, master and doctorate courses were held, reference letter(s), publications (if available), results of the GRE test, English language knowledge certified with IELTS, TOEFL or Cambridge Assessment	25 points max
Personal Statement	12 points max

2. Oral examination - Minimum score for eligibility: 30 points, Maximum score 50 points

English proficiency	10 points max
General knowledge of the PhD programme's main research topics and of the research topics	40 points max
linked to the available PhD positions	

Oral examination aims to assess the suitability of the applicant for scientific research as well as the general knowledge of issues encompassed by the PhD Programme. **The oral examination is carried out in English**.
