Professional Master's Programme description: outcomes/targets	<p>Pursuant to Decree no. 270 of 22 October 2004 of the Ministry of Education, University and Research, for academic year 2024/2025, Alma Mater Studiorum – Università di Bologna, Administrative office of Bologna, will run a 2nd-level Professional Master's Programme in "Clinical Endodontics".</p> <p>The Professional Master's Programme has been set up on the proposal of the Department of Department of Biomedical and Neuromotor Sciences - DIBINEM and in cooperation with Fondazione Alma Mater.</p> <p>The Professional Master's Programme aims to train master students into highly professional practitioners' individuals in the following fields: endodontics, surgical endodontics, pediatric endodontics, microscope endodontics – in order to perform 360° endodontics both in the division and in your private practice. Master students acquire the necessary skills to carry out correct endodontic diagnosis and x-ray assessment, CBCT, manage complex endodontic cases using both rotary and reciprocating systems and the ability to treat surgical endodontic cases using the operating microscope.</p> <p>It is aimed to dentistry graduates and medicine graduates who wish to direct their practice in endodontics, primary teeth endodontics, surgical endodontics and implant rehabilitation.</p>
Qualifications required for admission	<p>Second / single cycle degree obtained under D.M. 270/04 or second / single cycle degree obtained under the laws previously in force (DM 509/99 and Old Regulations) in the following fields or classes: LM-41 Degree in Medicine, LM-46 Dentistry and Orthodontics;</p> <p>- Second / single cycle degree obtained abroad deemed equivalent to those described in point above by the admission committee, for the purposes of admission to the Master;</p>
Other admission requirements (registration with a professional register, specialisation school, other qualifications, English proficiency, work experience, etc.)	A basic knowledge of Italian language

Auditors (if applicable)	<p>Participation is open to auditors, up to 20% of enrolled students.</p> <p>Those who wish to attend as auditors must inform directly the Professional Master's Programme secretariat and will be notified of the acceptance of their request, as well as of the deadline and methods for registration and payment of the attendance fee. The attendance fee for auditors is € 3.000,00 (threethousand/00 euros) (to be paid in a single instalment upon registration).</p> <p>Auditors do not sit the final exam, have no attendance obligation, are not required to do an internship or prepare project work, do not earn CFUs and are not awarded the Professional Master's qualification in Clinical Endodontics. The Secretariat will issue a certificate of attendance stating the number of hours completed by each auditor.</p>
