Maria Napoli is a Professor in Linguistics at the University of Eastern Piedmont. She is the Author of many contributions published in international journals and edited volumes. Her research interests mainly focus on Historical Linguistics and Language Typology. She graduated from the University of Pisa in 1999 (M.A. in Classics, with a specialization in Linguistics). In 2000 she got a PhD scholarship at the University of Pisa and received her PhD in Linguistics in 2003. Since then, she has taught Historical Linguistics, Sociolinguistics, General Linguistics, Applied Linguistics, Latin Language, Greek Grammar, Greek Linguistics at the University of Pisa, University of ‘Siena Stranieri’, ‘Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore’ of Milan and University of Eastern Piedmont. She participated in various projects and attended several international conferences, in some cases as an invited speaker. She was the principal investigator of the international project on *Textual*

Bilingualism in Latin (June 2015-2017). In March 2018, she was awarded the National Scientific Qualification (*Abilitazione Scientifica Nazionale*) for Full Professor.
