From 2016 to 2020, he was posted in East Jerusalem as Deputy EU Representative to the West Bank, Gaza and UNRWA.

In 2020, he returned to HQ as an Adviser for security policy and legal issues to the Managing Director for Asia and the Pacific, before taking up the position of EU Special Envoy and Head of Division in 2021.
