Parte B. RESUMEN DEL CV

Matías Mayor is PhD in Economics from the University of Oviedo (2007), becoming Full Professor of Applied Economics in 2021 at the same University. He was a visiting research at the Institute for Economic Research (Switzerland) in 2010. He currently has three complements of research productivity (positive evaluations).

He is fully involved in the university life with teaching, research and management tasks and responsibilities. In the research field, the common thread that runs through his contributions is the role of the space in the economic analysis applying spatial econometric models. His contributions focus mainly on these research lines: local labor markets and active labour policies using a regional focus, local strategic interactions and transport economy, accessibility and their effects on the economic regional performance. The research outcomes have been published in prestigious national and international journals indexed on Journal of Citation Report, included mostly of then in the ECONOMICS category. I would highlight the publications in journals included in the first quartile of the JCR (7): Regional Studies, Papers in Regional Science, Transportation Research A Research and Practice (2), Small Business Economics and Energy Policy.

He also has published some book chapters in international editorials (Springer, Edgar) and edited by prestigious researchers such as Giuseppe Arbia, Aura Reggiani, Javier Gutiérrez, Jean Claude Thill, Juan Prieto-Rodríguez, etc.

He belongs to the scientific board of Economics and Business Letters and Regional Studies, Regional Science and he is actively involved in the evaluation of papers as external reviewer in prestigious journal such as Economic Geography, Journal of Economic Behaviour and Organization, Regional Studies, Transportation Research A, Papers in Regional Science, Spatial Economic Analysis, among others.

He has worked on 9 competitive research projects since 2010, funded by the national government, national institutes and the regional government.

He is a member of the teaching team of the Interuniversity Master on Economic Analysis. Also, he belongs to two Doctoral Programs: Instruments of Economic Analysis and Business and Economics. Regarding to his international experience, he usually participates as a guest professor in the Master 'Resource Economics and Sustainable Development (Accessibility measures and regional labor markets) at the University of Bologna since 2014.

He held different management positions at the University of Oviedo. He has been Secretary and Vice Director of the Department of Applied Economics. He has been Vice Dean of School of Business and Economics (Oviedo, Asturias) 2010-2014 and nowadays he is the Head of the Department of Applied Economics since November 2017.
