

Prof. Dr. Hasan PEKER

Dr. Peker is a faculty member at the Istanbul University, Department of Ancient Languages and Cultures (since 2023 also Chair of Hittitology). He holds BAs in Hittitology and Near Eastern Archaeology, an MA and a PhD (2009) in Hittitology from the Istanbul University. He has taught Hittite and Luwian at Koç University between 2015–2016. He is teaching Hittite, Luwian and Ancient Egyptian at Istanbul and Boğaziçi Universities. He is interested in the political history and chronology of Anatolia and Syria in the Late Bronze and Iron Ages. In his latest publications he has reconstructed the new chronologies of the Late Hittite Kingdom Karkamis and Gurgum (Maraş). He is the Deputy Director of the Turco-Italian Archaeological Expedition at Karkemish. He is a Member of Turkish Institute of Archaeology and Chercheurs associés of IFEA.
