STATEMENT OF INTEREST

I believe that my combined academic background in logic, philosophy of science and public decision making initiatives along with my professional experience in designing and supervising ecosystems projects on contemporary art, urban regeneration artificial intelligence - involving public administrations, research centers, artists, profit and nonprofit organizations - could be beneficial for a research project in participatory design and artificial intelligence. In the last years I have developed, with the help of a growing community all over Europe, some art installations with AI technologies, involving several thousands citizens of different Italian cities. I have learnt how to engage people in approaching this complex and often perceived dystopian technology being at the center of most aspects of our lives. I am currently working on two projects connected to art, artificial intelligence and green transition and I think the value of the network involved and the outcomes produced could be useful for the present project.
