2. Summary of Contribution to Science

Constitutional and Comparative Constitutional Law: I have advanced aspects of constitutional theory, analyzing developments in Israel in a comparative perspective (related to Israel's constitutional evolution, freedom of expression, the role of courts and judicial independence (including under extreme conditions), and aspects of judicial review and interpretation).

Regulation, and in particular regulation of technology: I have examined the concept of regulation from various angles: the regulation of judges (including through technology), the regulation of cyber (and the role of the regulatory state in the cybernetic domain).

Legal Theory and Legal Culture: I have addressed jurisprudential questions related to the idea rights as distinct from public interests, the idea of the common law as distinct from statutory law or constitutional law, and the relationship between law and culture (primarily law and cinema, but also law and literature).

I intend to devote my next academic chapter to three main projects:

First, the completion of my book on the evolution of the Israeli constitutional project. A draft exists. The book analyzes Israel's three constitutional moments, and the current backlash. This book will fill an important gap in constitutional theory, and also address the unique evolution of the Israeli constitutional structure.

The second is to finally pursue my passion and write a short monograph on Luhmann's System Theory. I have presented papers on the topic, and now is the time to write a short book. This is related to the idea of Neo-Formalism, or formal legal pluralism, which has occupied my attention since my doctorate thesis. This project is philosophical in nature, and addresses my interest in jurisprudence.

Lastly, I see myself further expanding my interest in the conceptual relationship between law and technology, by focusing on the emergence of AI, as well as on the anticipated arrival of Quantum technologies and their theoretical implications on the idea of law and legal rules. This corresponds with my interest in Cyber, AI (e.g., the concept of the "smart") and the law, which I intend to further pursue, with a focus on the role of the state, constitutionalism, and regulation.
