- I am using Social-Life Cycle Assessment (S-LCA) together with theoretical models to assess the socio-economic impact of Healthcare Waste Management (HCWM)
- Chapter 1 is devoted to a scoping review of the role of S-LCA in the HCW sector. I have mastered managing a literature review with complete autonomy and efficiently creating search strings suitable for different contexts.
- Chapter 2 focuses on using the CVORR approach in analyzing the total value of the Frictional Heat Treatment system. During my 6-month traineeship at Newster System S.r.l, I have learnt how to draft a Business Model, and cooperate with a team of multidisciplinary experts from both business and academia.
- Chapter 3 is about investigating the problematics hindering the efficiency of the HCWM system at UZ Leuven (Belgium).

- I am improving the main analysis of chapter 1, and discussing and deepening the setup and research strategy of chapter 3 of my PhD thesis with the supervision of Prof. Simon De Jaeger.
