In 2019-22 Adriano Remiddi led a Global Campus project aimed at establishing the Human Rights Centre of the National University of Timor-Leste (UNTL) and is currently in charge of the GC Capacity Development programme that implements projects worldwide, at the nexus between academia and cooperation for development sector. In about 15 years spent dealing with Southeast Europe and later the Asia-Pacific region, he has developed a distinctive mix of academic and managerial skills, gaining a diversified and progressively responsible experience. Previously he worked as Academic Tutor and subsequently Coordinator of the GC South East Europe/ERMA on behalf of the Institute for Central-Eastern and Balkan Europe/University of Bologna (IECOB). As IECOB research fellow in regional studies he also lectured internationally, published, organised scientific conferences and participated in various panels as speaker.
