

CV BARBIERI EDOARDO

Edoardo Roberto Barbieri was born in Milan, the 11th of February 1961.

He teaches History of the Book and Publishing, Bibliology, History and forms of Writing in Catholic University in Milan and Brescia. He is Director of two Masters: Professione editoria (Working in Publishing) and Booktelling.

He has been scholarship holder at the University of Leuven (Belgium) for a long time (1986-87 and 1993), as well as visiting professor at the same University and at the Pazmany Peter University of Budapest (Hungary), at the Humanistic University of Moscow (Russia), at the Catholic University of Slovakia in Ruzomberok, at the ENSSIB in Lyon (France), at the Palacky University in Olomouc (Czech Republic) and for one semester in the University of Italian Switzerland in Lugano. He took part as speaker in many national and international conferences, and he gave several lectures on book history and the transmission of texts in Italian and foreign universities and cultural institutes.

He is director of the editorial series "Biblioteca di Bibliografia" (Florence, Olschki) and of «La Bibliofilia» (oldest international journal on the topic – Florence, Olschki)

He was member of the Consiglio Superiore dei Beni culturali e Paesaggistici (Higher council of cultural and landscape goods) and now of the Technical Committee for the Libraries of the Ministry of Culture.
