She is a published author and enjoys writing collaboratively, with recent work in *Border Abolition* (Pluto Press, 2024), *Undocumented International* (The Funambulist, 2024), and *Contemporary Representations of Forced Migration in Europe* (Palgrave Studies in Literature, Culture, and Human Rights, 2023).
