## Short C.V. of Charoula Stathopoulou

Charoula Stathopoulou is an Emeritus Professor at the University of Thessaly, specializing in the sociopolitical dimensions of Mathematics Education and equity-driven reform. With over 150 publications, her research focuses on transforming mathematics pedagogy to address systemic inequities, particularly for vulnerable populations such as Roma communities and incarcerated youth. She has led large-scale projects like Common Spaces for Roma Integration (<a href="http://cospirom.sed.uth">http://cospirom.sed.uth</a>), ACTinPRISON (<a href="https://actinprison.sed.uth.gr">https://actinprison.sed.uth.gr</a>), which align with the vision to center mathematics education on human rights and ecological justice.
