Federico Zanfi is an architect and Associate Professor of Urbanism at Politecnico di Milano, where he coordinates the master's degree program in Landscape Architecture. He serves on the board of the PhD program in Urbanism at the IUAV University in Venice. His design and research focus on the transformations of contemporary cities and territories in response to socioeconomic and environmental shifts, with a particular emphasis on adapting the built environment. He has carried out scientific consultancy for the drafting of urban plans for cities such as Modena (2016-2019) and Lecce (2022-2024). Among his recent books: *What's Next for Mom and Dad's House?
