Her research focuses on Chilean cinema, film festivals, cultural diplomacy, and the development of audiences and film cultures in Chile. She is co-author of 'Film Festivals and Anthropology', 'Chilefilms, el Hollywood Criollo' and 'La vieja escuela: el rol del cine arte Normandie en la formación de audiencias'. She was the lead researcher of the research projects 'Film Festivals: Experiences of Formation and Expansion of the Chilean cultural field' and 'Chilean film audiences: film culture, cinephilia and education' (Fondecyt 1211594). She is also the curator of the exhibition 'Cine en Chile: Historia(s) en Movimiento' (Santiago, CCLM, 2026).
