Dissertation developed around three papers:

- Paper #1 (Poli, S., Loots, E., & Stam, E., *Community events supporting entrepreneurial ecosystem: evidence from Lucca Comics & Games*) starts from the phenomenon-driven question "how does a festival come to support entrepreneurs" to understand how a festival (Lucca Comics & Games) can fulfill the function of an entrepreneurial ecosystem. Through a longitudinal case study analyses of festival archival data, interviews, and observations, the paper contributes to entrepreneurial ecosystem literature showing the key role played by the community and its strong willingness to support itself in fostering the emergence of a temporary but mature community-based entrepreneurial ecosystem, able to fill the lack of the artists' original entrepreneurial ecosystems.
- Paper #2 (Poli, S., *Supporting entrepreneurship in the creative and cultural sector: an entrepreneurial support organisation's perspective*) explores how entrepreneurial support organisations specialised in supporting creative and cultural entrepreneurship design their activities to address some crucial problems: an unstable and unclear sector definition, the double success criterion (in order to grow, entrepreneurs must balance entrepreneurial financial gains and cultural recognition), and the pressure from policymakers to generate a positive spillover effect. Through a longitudinal case study approach, it observes the evolution of the calls for competition promoted by a program supporting local startups and associations. The paper contributes to entrepreneurial support literature identifying how different parts of the calls for competition can be used to leverage some mechanisms to solve specific supporting problems.
- Paper #3 (Poli, S., Grimaldi, R., & Vitani, E., *Entrepreneurial support integration in multi-layered entrepreneurial ecosystem*) investigates how actors at different layers of an entrepreneurial ecosystem support entrepreneurs and integrate their supporting efforts over time. The paper uses an in-depth longitudinal case study of an Italian Region to observe entrepreneurial support initiatives at the macro (governmental bodies), meso (entrepreneurial support organisations) and micro (entrepreneurs) layers, and their evolution in over 40 years. The paper contributes to entrepreneurial ecosystem literature deepening our understanding of multi-layer dynamics, and to entrepreneurial support literature observing the interplay of different layers in supporting entrepreneurs.
