

Instructions for Filling in the Form

Dear Legal Officer or Delegate of the Company/Entity

Here are some brief instructions on how to fill in the form "Declaration of Readiness to Accept Trainees for Practical Traineeship (TPV)". Please follow each step:

- 1. **Declaration of Willingness**: Fill in basic information about yourself and your organisation and indicate whether you are willing, at the end of this short process, to enter or renew a Convention with the University of Bologna, if there is not already one in place, for the implementation of TPV activities.
- 2. **Commitments of the company/institution**: Fill in the commitments that your company/institution intends to make regarding the traineeship, such as compliance with regulations, supervision of trainees and non-replacement of staff with trainees.
- 3. Annex 1 'Information about your entity': On this page, you are asked to indicate basic information and internship locations.
- 4. Annex 2 "List of tutor-psychologists": Fill in all the necessary fields indicating the names of the tutor psychologists, ensuring that they are suitably qualified and meet the requirements (the contract must provide for an hourly commitment and a duration at least equal to the commitment required by the tutor assignment, i.e. at least 15 hours per week for the entire duration of the placement) specified in the regulations. ATTENTION: If a tutor psychologist works in more than one location, make sure that this location has been included in Annex 1.
- 5. Annex 3/4 'Project and Learning Objectives': There are two projects, one for master's and postgraduate degrees and one for three-year degrees. It must be specified whether this project is valid for all the locations indicated in Annex 1.
- 6. **Format and Digital Signature**: The document must be drawn up exclusively in digital format. The digital signature must be affixed using a specific programme and must come from a recognised Certification Authority (CA) and adhere to the CAdES or PAdES standards.
 - Please avoid hand-written compilation. After completing and digitally signing the document, please send it by e-mail to the Traineeships and International Relations Office Cesena at <u>campuscesena.tirocini@unibo.it</u> or PEC <u>scriviunibo@pec.unibo.it</u> for the attention of the Office.
- 7. **Evaluation of the Application**: The University of Bologna Order of Psychologists of Emilia-Romagna Integrated Traineeships Commission will evaluate the documentation. Supplements may be requested and, based on the evaluation, your Entity may be invited to enter into or renew the Agreement wit the University, if there is not already one in place.

I DECLARE

to be willing to accept graduates and students of degree courses qualifying for Psychology and to be willing, at the conclusion of this procedure, to enter into or renew, if there is not one already in place, an **agreement** with the University of Bologna for the implementation, at the Company/Body I represent, of Pratical Traineeship (hereinafter TPV) activities valid for access to the Practical Assessment Test for the qualification to practise as a psychologist.

To this end, under my own responsibility and aware of the penal sanctions provided for in Article 76 of Presidential Decree 445 of 28/12/2000 for the hypotheses of falsity in deeds and mendacious declarations indicated herein,

I FURTHER DECLARE

- 1) That the Company/Body I represent (or a specific sector of it) carries out **interventions of a psychological nature**, as shown in the TPV Project (Annexes 3 and/or 4).
- 2) To be clear about the professional distinction between psychologist and psychotherapist.
- 3) That all activities reserved for the profession of psychologist are performed exclusively by psychologists or psychology graduates.
- 4) That the professionals identified as tutors have a consistent and systematic professional relationship with the Company/Body represented by me as employees/collaborators/consultants and that, regardless of their contractual classification, they carry out professional activities typical of a psychologist, with a contract that provides for an hourly commitment and a duration at least equal to the commitment required by the position of psychologist tutor, i.e. at least 15 hours per week for the entire duration of the traineeship
- 5) That it is ensured that trainees can directly participate in the activities considered basic for their professional training.

I FINALLY COMMIT MYSELF TO

- 1) Ensure that trainees are not used as a replacement for employees or collaborators, as the traineeship cannot be considered as an additional professional resource.
- 2) Ensure that each tutor does not supervise more than **five trainees** at the same time.
- 3) Ensure that the trainee only carries out his or her experience within the organisational sub-units of the company/organisation in which the activity of the tutor is in any case ensured.
- 4) Do not in any way make acceptance and performance of traineeship activities conditional on:
 - a. requests to participate in preparatory or ongoing activities requiring a financial burden on the trainee;
 - b. requests for additional insurance coverage beyond that already guaranteed by the University.
- 5) Please inform the Traineeships and International Relations Office of any changes to this declaration.
- 6) Inform the tutor:
 - a. of what is contained in this Declaration signed between the Company/Body I represent and the University;
 - b. that at the end of the placement he/she is obliged to send the relevant university a final assessment of the outcome of the placement by completing a form provided by the university;

¹ NOTE: According to current legislation (Law 163/2021), the skills to be acquired during the apprenticeship are:

- Evaluation of individual cases, dyads, groups or organisations
- Correct use of psychological assessment tools and techniques
- Formulation of intervention hypotheses based on theoretical foundations and scientific evidence
- Ability to analyse, listen and connect with the context and users
- Reporting and feedback to patients, customers, users, institutions or organisations
- Independent and critical reflection on experience
- Linking theories, tools and psychological practice
- Establishing appropriate relations with colleagues
- Knowledge and management of the ethical and deontological implications of the activities performed.
- This excludes competences that relate to the profession of psychotherapist.

Annex 4 TRAINEESHIP PROJECT: EXPECTED LEARNING OBJECTIVES, SKILLS AND METHODS (for Bachelor Degree)

The three-year TPV traineeship (L-24) follows the Guidelines established by the CPA-AIP on 10/11/2022 and focuses on three main objectives:

- 1. Development of Knowledge and Skills: The internship aims to provide technical and operational knowledge as well as procedural skills. The student will learn the basic principles for the correct application of procedures and the effective use of psychological tools.
- 2. Understanding the Professional Context: Through the internship activities, the student will gain an initial understanding of the professional context in psychology. This includes familiarisation with the different requirements of the field, the formats and areas of intervention, and the contexts in which psychological practice takes place.
- 3. Practical Application: The training focuses on the ability to use tools and procedures typical of the professional psychologist. Examples include administering and interpreting psychological tests, conducting and evaluating behavioural observations, and using software for statistical analysis. This approach is designed to develop the student's 'practice capacity', i.e. the ability to apply theoretical knowledge in practical situations.
