The aim of the course is to provide useful skills in assessing individual and environmental vulnerability factors to neuro-socio-development disorders, from birth to early adulthood, also providing elements for their diagnosis and treatment.

The main recipients of the proposed training are therefore all those professionals variously involved in the identification and management of such vulnerabilities in any hospital setting or in the Community Mental Health Services: physicians, psychologists. nurses, psychiatric rehabilitation educators. therapists and other healthcare and psychosocial professionals.

The lessons, for a total of 55 hours, will take place from March to May2023 online on Microsoft Teams.

LEARNING GOALS

Acquisition of skills and competences relative to:

- assessment of socio-environmental and cultural risk factors for mental health during pregnancy, puerperium, infancy, adolescence, early adulthood;
- recognition and management of main somatic manifestations of mental and social distress in the child, as well as signs of maltreatment, abuse and violence;
- identification and treatment of pervasive developmental disorders, autism, externalizing disorders;
- assessment of cognitive linguistics abilities and learning disorders;
- presentation and treatment of main mental disorders of the early adulthood such as autism and Asperger's, mental states at risk of psychosis, psychotic onset;
- knowledge of the influence of culture and migration history on psychopathology manifestations.
