EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

I am an historian and epigraphist of the Late Antique and Byzantine world with good archaeological skills. I received my BA in Classics (2014-2017) and a MA in Classical Philology (2017-2020) at the University of Florence with a master thesis on the Greek Christian inscriptions of Crete from the 4th to the 8th century. While at University I developed my interests in byzantine epigraphy and archaeology, focused on Greece in particular.

I have been a post-graduate student with a 2 years' fellowship in Late Antique and Byzantine Archaeology (2021-2022) at the Italian Archaeological School at Athens, a high-level research institution that focuses on the archaeology of the Greek and Roman Mediterranean. I could implement my academic formation through a series of seminars, classes, lectures ranging from the Bronze Age's archaeology to the Byzantine studies, with professors from various Italian universities and other foreign institutions. Here, I have focused my research on the Late Antique and Byzantine epigraphic material from Greece, with a focus on the island of Lemnos in Northern Aegean. For my thesis work at the Italian Archaeological School, I dealt with history, archaeology and epigraphy of Lemnos in the Early and Middle Byzantine period.

I am currently a Phd student at the University of Bologna and I am conducting research on historical Byzantine inscriptions from the period of the so-called Dark Ages.

My research interests span various topics within the broader discipline of Byzantine history and archaeology, including archaeology in Greece and Crete from the Late Antique to the Middle Byzantine period, history, archaeology and epigraphy of the Northern Aegean islands, the study of byzantine inscriptions in their archaeological, political and social context, history of Italian archaeology.
