Research Interests

North Indian premodern and modern literature (Hindi, Braj bhasha and early modern Punjabi) especially relating to mystic poetry and lyrics of Hindustani art music. Hindi female poetry in art music and poetry as resistance. The role of women in Indian music and dance, history of music from Mughal times until today, colonial and post-colonial history, the modern cultural reform of the 20th Century, the marginalization of hereditary professional Indian musicians, social activism through music and poetic forms in North India. Genres and genders, liminality in Hindustani music. Connections between lyrics, gestures and expression in Indian music. The art music tradition of Benares, female singers of Benares and their repertoire. Interaction between Sufi poetry and bhakti poetry. Aesthetics of Indian music in ancient and modern literature through the lens of the phenomenological categories of form and event.

Teaching Interests & Abilities

I have been teaching different disciplines from languages to music, to research and more theoretical subjects, both in presence and online, for the last 13 years. For this reason, my teaching methods avail of a multidisciplinary approach. I tend to encourage a practical and interactive approach and to inspire my students to find their own voice and style of learning and researching. I like to experiment and try different teaching tools and methods. I consider it vital to be a constant learner myself and can, thus, empathize with issues students may face when approaching a subject. I have mentored two students for MMus theses on Hindustani music.

Contribution/Other

Currently, I am the only Western scholar who has taught north Indian art music at academic institutions in Europe in the last few years, and I am the only Westerner to have

ever taught at the same time Hindi language and Indian Music in academic institutions. I am currently publishing for an Italian publisher a unique translation project of an anthology of Hindi poets translated into Italian and selected by me. I've been the first one to apply the aesthetic theory of Italian philosopher Carlo Diano to Indian art music. I have peer reviewed a paper and a volume of essays.
